

Climate Action Bingo

Here's how to play



There are different ways to use the Climate Action Bingo sheet.

- 1** You can play it as a group. One person calls out an action and everyone who has done this before will cross it off their sheet. Once all the actions have been read out, the winner is those with the highest number of actions crossed off.
- 2** You can use it individually. Take the sheet home with you and see how many of the climate actions you can do in a week and in a month. Report back to your friends the next time you meet up.
- 3** You may have your own ideas of how you would like to use the Climate Action Bingo sheet.
