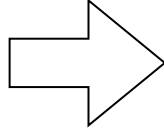
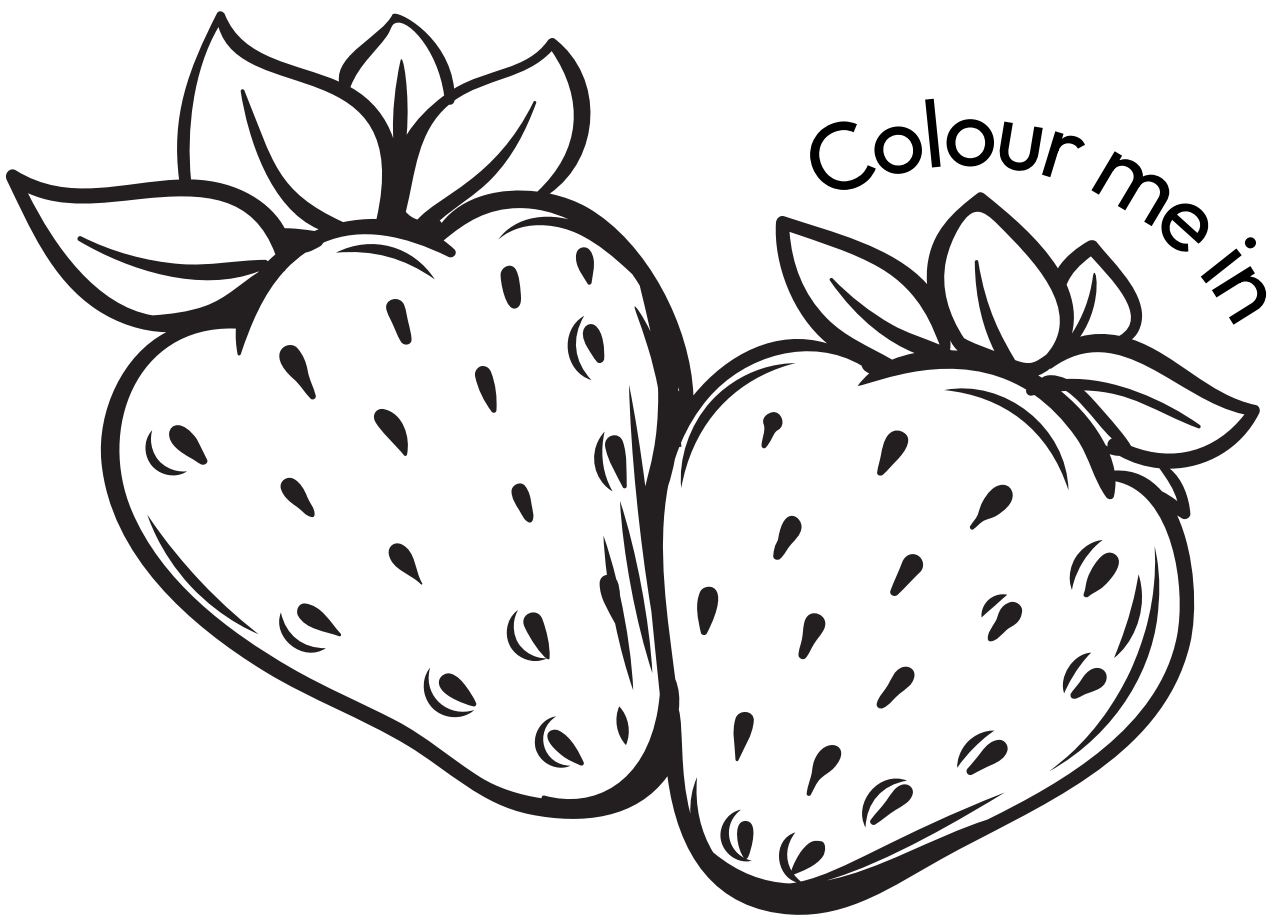


A Strawberry's Climate Journey

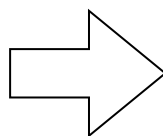
It takes a lot of carbon to grow and transport strawberries in the colder months.
